The North Rim Visitor Center is adjacent to Grand Canyon Lodge The hike across the canyon from South Rim to North Rim is 21 miles (34 km). However, driving from the South Rim to the North Rim by automobile requires a 4.5 hour drive of 220 miles (354 km).
